

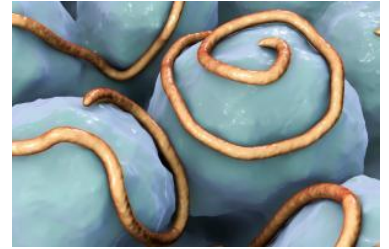


Worms
