Welcome back to school for the summer term.

There have been not changes to arrangements to minimise the risk of a Covid outbreak since the end of last term, so I just wanted to remind you of a few things:

- Class 2 and 3 to arrive for 9:00 am, then Class 1 at 9:05 am. Gates close at 9:10 am.
- Parents must inform school if any of your family, including yourselves, display Covid symptoms.
- Children with Covid symptoms must be kept off school and have a test – if negative, they may return to school.
- The school will contact you and ask for your child to be collected if they display symptoms whilst at school.
