Academy Update

Last Wednesday our stakeholder consultation process completed, with regards to the school joining the Saffron Academy Trust. There was only one formal response to this process and this was from one of our parents who was in support of the proposal. Therefore, at their meeting last Thursday, the Governing Body have agreed to proceed with this process.

There are still many steps for both the school and the academy trust to take in order for this take place in our desired timescale of September 2022. This includes getting the Regional School Commissioner to agree to our school joining the Saffron Academy Trust and for the trust to agree with the Local Authority all elements of the legal process that are required. The legal processes can sometimes take longer than hoped, so there is a possibility that we will not convert to an academy until later in the next academic year, rather than September. I will try to keep parents and carers as up-to-date as possible on these matters, so you know what is happening.
