Both Mrs Lunn and I have spoken to the children on separate occasions last week about the dangers with this type of behaviour. It should go without saying, that I do not want to be phoning any parent to say that their child has been involved in a serious accident, or worse still, a fatality.

I would therefore be grateful if parents in Class 3 could speak about road safety, and acting responsibly, to their children , if they are allowed to walk to/from school on their own or with their friends.

If any child continues to act irresponsibly prior to entering our school grounds and/or on their way home from school, then I will ask that a parent accompanies them at all times and the privilege of walking to/from school on their own is removed.
