Dinner Money

I have been asked to remind families that they shouldn't be asking for their child/children to have a school lunch unless it has been paid for. Equally, they should not owe money to the school for school meals received, so if you have an outstanding debt, please settle this up as quickly as possible.

Our School Meals Debt Policy states that:

- A. All school lunches must be paid for in advance;
- B. No child should be sent to school with no money in their account and expect to be given a
- C. Parents who do not want their child to have a school meal should provide a healthy, nut-free, packed lunch.
- D. Parents who have a debt between £2 and £25 will receive a balance reminder from the school office. Debts larger than this will be referred to the Headteacher & Governing Body if not settled and the school can refuse to serve meals for that child.
