Academy update

On the Friday before half term, we received the news from the Department for Education, that the Regional School Commissioner has approved our request to become part of the Saffron Academy Trust.

The DfE have subsequently sent a message to say that there is not a long enough timeframe to make this happen between now and September. Therefore, after discussing this with Caroline Derbyshire, the CEO of SAT, we have agreed to aim for January 2023. Until we do convert, we will remain a Local Authority school.

Whilst we will endeavour to convert to an academy in January 2023, the Saffron Academy Trust are still in negotiations with the Local Authority about getting a legal commitment for them to carry out some Health & Safety work on our school site, so this process could lead to a further delay.
