We are delighted to be partnering with Just One Tree again this year, to help plant trees in parts of the world with extreme poverty. Last year we raised £99, so planted 99 trees.

This year, Just One Tree day is on **Friday 14**th **October** and your child can wear non-uniform to celebrate this (it can be green, but not required).

Many families are sadly affected by cancer, in one way or another. At this present time, one of our families is dealing with breast cancer, so they have asked whether we can support the 'Wear it Pink' day on **Friday 21**st **October**.
