Is the school closing?

I have been made aware that there seems to be concern over whether or not our school is going to close in the near future. I want to reassure families there are no plans to close the school and the restructuring and redundancy process we went through in 2020 has put us in a sustainable position financially.

I think the concern may emanate from the DfE, as they list on their website that we are going to close. This is purely them following procedure when a school plans to convert to an academy, as effectively the old version of the school 'closes' to be replaced by an academy version. Of course, as parents will know, the academy conversion process has been put on hold for the foreseeable future, so we will remain a Local Authority maintained school.

Class 2 & 3 were honoured to join the remembrance service at the Ashdon War Memorial to mark Armistice Day, after the children had learnt about the heroic actions of Mrs Elizabeth Everitt during World War II.
