New playground trim trail

You will have seen from the recent PTA newsletter that they are looking to fund one of the pieces of equipment for our new trim trail.

Last term I invited different companies to quote for the removal and replacement of the current wooden trim trail. This is because we are having to regularly replace some of the wooden posts/logs that make up the existing equipment, which is costly but it also means the equipment can be out of use for weeks/months whilst waiting for the repair to be carried out.

Therefore, the governors have agreed to have steel-based equipment that should last a minimum of 25 years. There are 3 main parts to this new trim trail which are illustrated below. We hope to have the work completed by the end of the Easter holiday at the latest.
