They learned a variety of techniques using clay e.g. instead of adding pieces of clay onto each other they learned to pull, stretch and shape it from the main piece of clay used.

Around 40,000 years ago they would use a variety of objects of emboss patterns onto the clay, but in modern clay items artist glaze items.
