Uniform Business!

Dear Parents and Carers,

I want to thank everyone that took part in the previous uniform surveys this term. I shared the results of what you, our parents and carers wanted with regards to our uniform. I appreciate the suggestions, conversations and opinions raised. This made it really a much more holistic approach, where you, our parents and carers had an opportunity to have a voice.

The parents and carers voted for the polo shirts to stay (with or without a logo). You also voted that we will have only the navy blue trousers, skirts, pinafores and shorts going forward. This means that the grey items will not be part of our uniform. This was discussed with our governors and they were all in agreement for this to be actioned.

I mentioned in one of our previous newsletters that I will discuss the 'phase out' period with or governors as well and here are the arrangements suggested and agreed:

Autumn term 2023: Pupils can continue to wear grey items for this term as many might have grey summer uniform items left.

Spring term 2024: Pupils can continue to wear grey items for this term as many might have grey winter uniform items left. The phase-out period will end by the end of this term.

Summer term 2024: Pupils will be expected to wear navy items from this term onwards and no grey items to be allowed anymore.

P.E from September 2023:

We want to remind parents that all children will not be able to come to school wearing their P.E kits. All children will get dressed for P.E in school. They will leave their P.E kits in school and these will be sent home at the end of each 'short term' to be washed. We need to ensure that our pupils come to school and have the correct P.E kits. We would like parents to make sure that children do not have other items that are not part of our P.E uniform. We had a lot of really positive feedback regarding this.


Reading Comprehension: 90% Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: 80%
