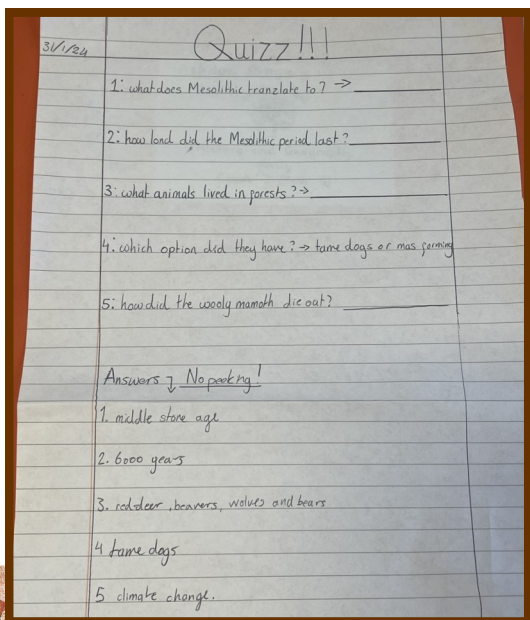
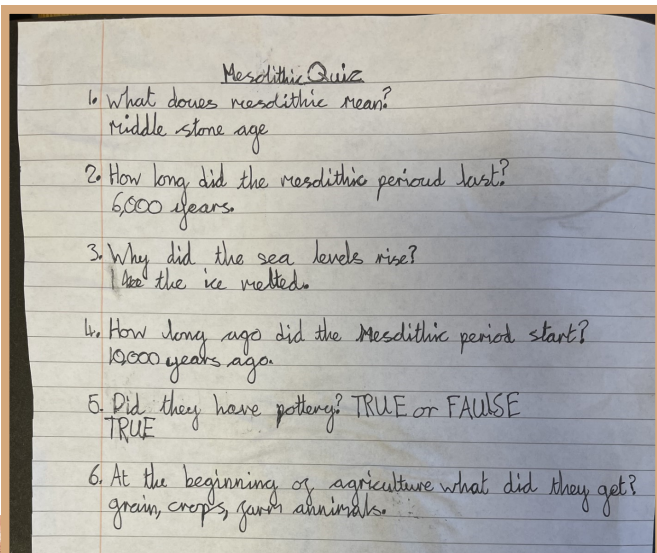
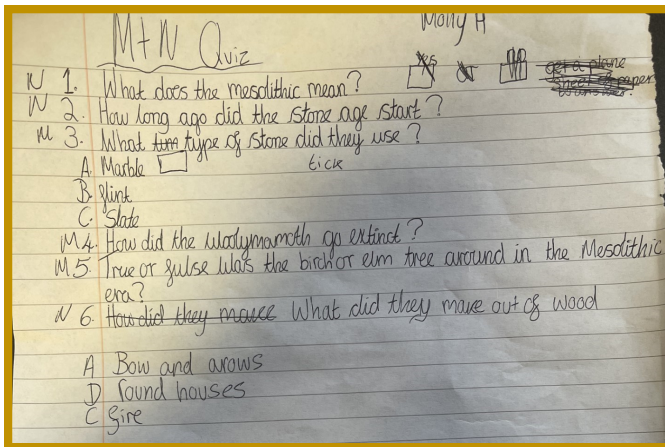
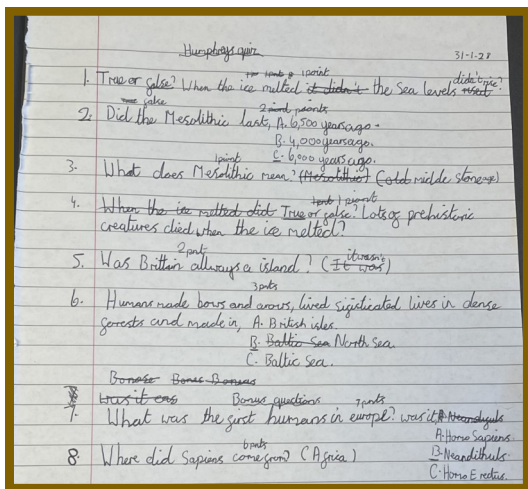
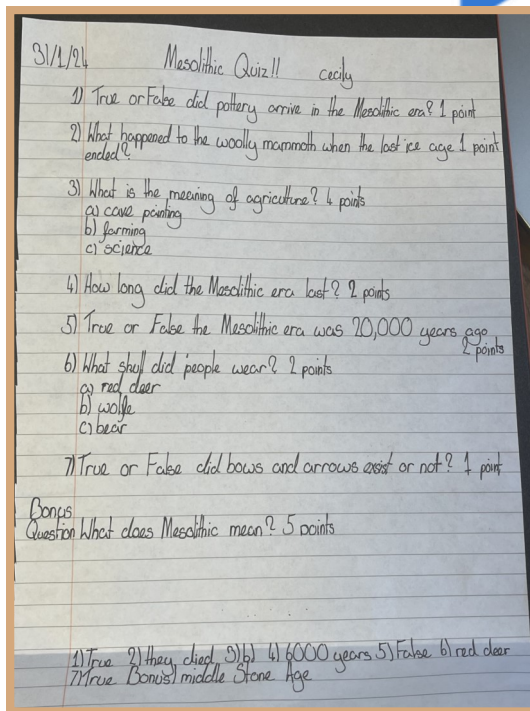




Mesolithic Period

Reading Challenge

The reading challenge for this half term holiday is that you should read every day and make sure an older sibling, parent, grandparent, auntie or uncle writes in your reading record that you read either your whole phonics book or 10 minutes for the day.

Reward for taking part in this: 5 Dojo points if pupils can show that they read every day this half term holiday.

Maths Challenge

For all pupils, who have access to TimesTables Rockstars, Numbots or Mathsletics, to go onto these websites and practise your mathematics skills.

*For those who cannot seem to log onto the websites or do not have WiFi - if you can write out your times tables, show long addition/subtraction/multiplication or division sums, and bring this to school after the holidays, this will be fine. For Reception or Year 1 pupils to write their numerals and bring that to school after the holiday, this will be more than fine as well.

Reward for taking part in this: 5 Dojo points if your parents can confirm with a small note to the class teacher that you practised every day on any of these websites. Pupils can also bring to school any work they completed for maths at home - this must be given to the class teacher on the first day of term though.

Writing Challenge

For pupils to write at least 3 pieces of writing and bring this with them to school on the first day back. Pupils in Reception or Year 1 can write their names and write random High Frequency Words and bring these in.

Reward for taking part in this: 5 Dojo points if you bring all your writing pieces into school the first day after half term.

You can choose the activities you would like to take part in - we are not prescribing what you should do. We merely want our pupils to continue learning if they would like to earn a few Dojo points. We would look at effort made and award Dojos if we think the effort was really good. Your child doesn't have to take part in any of the challenges if they do not want to. This is merely an opportunity for them to receive Dojo points for continued learning. Your child must bring in the work they would like to submit or the parent note that states that they did complete maths activities on a said website on 26th February. Any notes/work submitted after the 26th February will not be taken into account. I might even 'throw in' a few lovely, shiny or smelly stickers!
