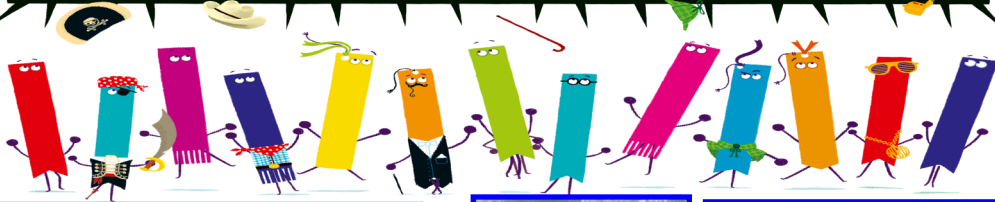

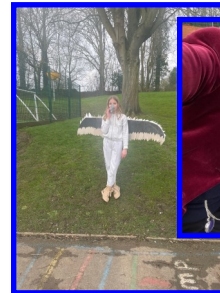
Poem for World Book Day
