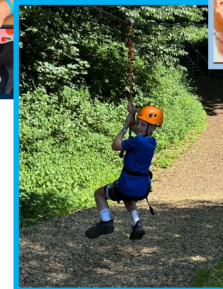
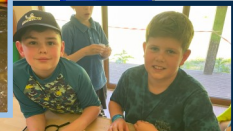
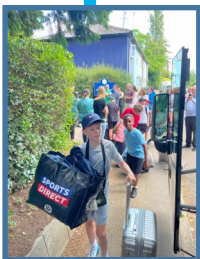


High Spirits @ Hautbois!

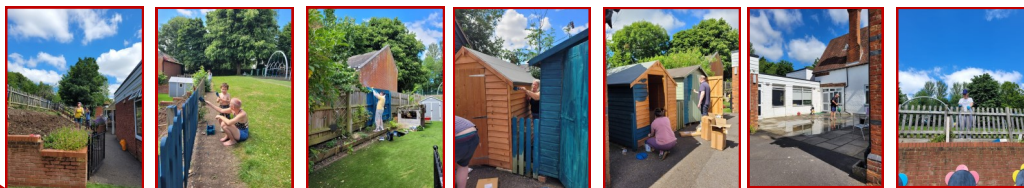
A HUGE THANK YOU!
