
Hadstock Writing Competition!

Reminder about Reporting Absences and Vomiting/Diarrhoea:

Parents and carers must call the school before 9.10am if their child is unwell to report their absence, as well as the reason why their child is absent. If we do not know why a child is not in school, it is an unauthorised absence, so please keep the office up to date. Additionally, if your child has been vomiting and/or had diarrhoea, it is policy that they must stay at home for 48 hours after the last episode, in order to limit the spread of such illnesses. Additionally, if a child has had a serious bout of diarrhoea, called cryptosporidiosis, they will not be allowed to swim for the following two weeks.
