We have used atlases, globes and books, as well as the internet to find out as much as we can. We may be heading off on our...

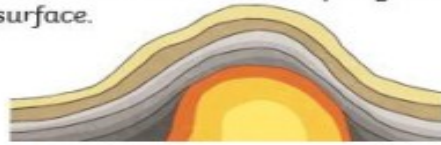

We used fudge icing to recreate a volcanic mountain.



Here we showed how erosion, caused by wind and rain, creates a plateau mountain.



Here, the children are demonstrating how a fold mountain is formed, with jumpers representing tectonic plates pushing up against each other.



Emily demonstrated how a fault block mountain is formed.



Class 3 looked at how different kinds of mountains are formed, using everyday items! Mountains grow really slowly; Mt Everest, the world's tallest mountain, gets 4mm taller each year. So during the ten years our Year 6s have been alive, Everest has grown 40mm taller!
